News From Austria:



Parliamentary Election in Austria: Nationalratswahlen: Sunday, September 29, 2019:

After the No-confidence vote in the parliament in June, triggered by major corruption scandals, the government coalition ÖVP/FPÖ under then Chancellor Kurz had to resign and new elections are to be held. For the interims time, President VanderBellen nominated the former head of Austria's Constitutional Court, Dr. Brigitte Bierlein, as Chancellor who then nominated 12 highly qualified persons (6 women and 6 men) as heads of the different departments. The work of this interim government, led by experts in their fields, is praised and welcomed by the Austrian public.

Every Austrian citizen older than 16 years is eligible to vote!! Austrians living abroad can vote using an absentee ballot. You need to be registered with the election office of the community where you had the strongest ties. The registration can be done ANYTIME, also online. Please refer to this link: https://www.bmeia.gv.at/reise-aufenthalt/leben-im-ausland/wahlen/ for more information, the application form, and a guideline how to determine "your" election community. At the registration form you can opt for the 10-years ABO option, that means for the next 10 years you will get the absentee ballots automatically sent to you without any further steps necessary.

After you receive the absentee ballot, please return the completed ballot **immediately** to your respective election office using the provided pre-paid return envelope - to make sure the ballots arrive in time.

IMPORTANT: To be eligible to vote for the upcoming election, you need to be registered (Eintragung in die Wählerevidenz) LATEST by August 8, 2019. http://botschaft.austria.org/wahlen. So, only a few days left! Please also see attached letter from Consul General of Austria in Los Angeles, Andreas Launer, for further information.

OTHER NEWS:

New appointments of the most important positions in the European Parliament following the European Elections in May: 2 prominent women in top positions:

Ursula von der Leyen, 60, trained physician, current minister of defense of Germany, previous minister of several other resorts, mother of 7, got nominated for the highest job within the EU: EU Commissioner (succeeding Jean-Claude Juncker). On July 16, Ursula VonDerLeyen was confirmed as the first woman in this highest position within the EU.

Christine Lagarde, 63, currently head of the International Monetary Fund (IMF) since 2011, nominated for the European Central Bank (succeeding Mario Draghi)

July: Heat Wave in Europe: Hardest hit were Spain and France. In Paris, temperature soared to 42 degrees Celsius (107 Fahrenheit), a new temperature record. In Austria, highs reached "only" 101.5F (38.6C). One heat record chased another one.

July 25: An over 100 years old Egon Schiele drawing was discovered in a New York Habitat for Humanity thrift store, and it could be worth more than \$100,000. The finder plans to donate part of the sales revenue to Habitat for Humanity.
